| <p>Science Who Am I? Autumn 1 Children will be identifying, naming, drawing and labelling basic parts of the human body and saying which part of the body is associated with each sense. Celebrations Autumn 2 We will be distinguishing objects from the materials they are made from, identifying and naming a variety of everyday materials and describing the simple physical properties of everyday materials. Seasons Autumn 1 & Autumn 2 Children observe changes across the seasons throughout the year and observe and describe weather and day length.</p> | <p>History Why do we remember the 5th of November? -Autumn 2 In this unit the children will explore the history behind, and the significance of, Bonfire Night on 5th November, using stories and sources. They will develop an understanding of where events fit within a chronological framework and narrative, and a curiosity about the past.</p> | <p>Geography Around Our School and Local Area - Autumn 1 In this unit the children will use maps, photographs, simple fieldwork and observational skills to study the school and the surrounding environment. They will be introduced to a variety of features that form part of their local area and understand the part people play in developing and changing the area.</p> |
| <p>R.E Creation Autumn 1 We will be looking at what responsibility God has given people about taking care of creation. The Saints Autumn 2 In this unit we will be looking at why the saints are important to Christianity. Christmas Autumn 2 Children will learn about the characters in the nativity and why they are important.</p> | <p>Music Autumn Term: Moving on from the skills developed in Reception, children continue to develop their musicianship through their voices, movement and enjoyment. Co-ordination is developed and vocal control starts to get given Kodaly labels (doh-re-mi etc) and hand signs. (DaCapo syllabus). Class performances happen at Christmas. <i>Listening: Prokofiev, Peter and the Wolf, Peter's theme and The Bird</i></p> | <p>Computing Finding images using the web- Autumn 1 Children will use web search engines to collect pictures of different types of animals and then explore ways in which those pictures can be organised. Create a card digitally- Autumn 2 Children will create a digital greetings card.</p> |
| <p>D & T Moving Pictures - Autumn 2 In this unit, children develop an understanding of simple mechanisms through designing and making moving pictures. Children develop their understanding of how movement can be created by investigating everyday products and making simple levers and sliders from given examples.</p> | <p>Art Drawn To The Light and Shadows- Autumn 1 and 2 Children will be developing skills in drawing by looking at texture, line, shape and form. There will be a focus on the work of Leonardo da Vinci and David Hockney.</p> | <p>P.E Ball skills & games To be able to dribble with the ball under control.
