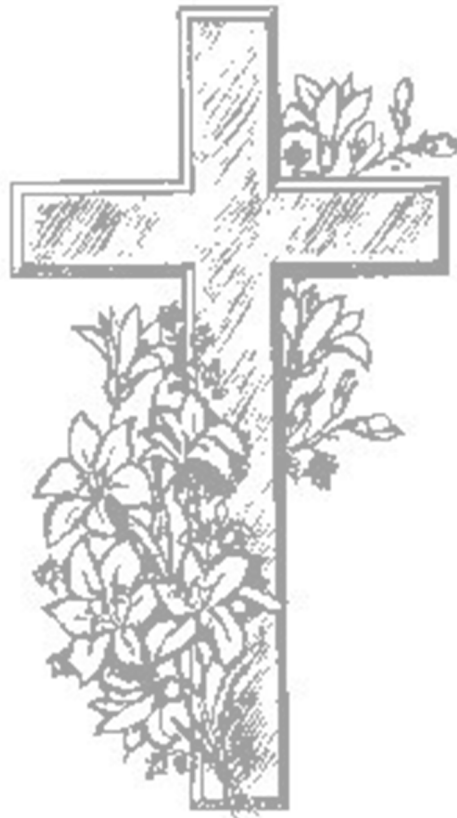

Jesus Appears to Mary Magdalene

John 20:11-18

Mary stood crying outside the tomb.
