<p><u>LO: To use the 'Make 100p' strategy to add 2 amounts of money</u></p> <p>I can:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use number bonds to 100 to help add two amounts of money • Regroup 100p to make £1, when there is more than 100p in total <p>Task 1: See attached sheet</p>	<p><u>LO: To explore extended sentences</u></p> <p>I can:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Describe what I see, hear, smell and feel • Extend my sentences <p><u>Task 1:</u></p> <p>Watch MarshMallows clip (they've worked on this before). Look for as many details about the setting as possible. Record in note form as much information about the setting as you can remember.</p> <p>Watch clip for a second time and pay attention <i>only</i> to the setting and not the characters / action. How many other things do you notice? Can you explain where they were? Add to notes.</p> <p>Freeze clip at 6 secs. Look at the document 'setting sentences'.</p> <p>Can you write your notes into sentences such as these, and start with preposition phrases?</p> <p>I'm looking for around 6-8 sentences, at least 3 need to start with a fronted adverbial (in this case saying WHERE something was)</p> <p>Lesson to continue tomorrow...</p>	<p><u>LO: To understand the function of muscles</u></p> <p><u>Task 1:</u></p> <p>You will need to work with a sibling or parent for this! Remember that one of the main functions of the skeleton is movement? Muscles help with this. Feel some of the muscles in your body. What do they feel like?</p> <p>Open the document 'muscle activities'</p> <p>Carry out the exercises detailed as many times as you can for 1 minute each (use a timer).
