

Session 1	<p>Maths- Perimeter</p> <p>10 min warm up: Square numbers https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/hit-the-button-square numbers</p> <p>LO: Estimate, calculate and compare perimeters WI and/or WA</p> <p>30 mins activity: Using any measuring tool you like (feet, hands, steps, cm, m) First estimate, then calculate and finally compare the perimeter of two rooms in your house</p> <p>Resources: Tape measure (optional) homework book and pencil</p> <p>Tips: 4 steps is roughly 3 metres. Perimeter is the distance around the outside of a shape calculated by adding the length of all sides together.
