<p><u>LO: To find fractions of quantities</u></p> <p>Maths Task 1 – Most of you should be able to complete this without much help...</p> <p>Maths Task 2 – You should complete Task 2 if you are really confident with finding fractions of amounts...</p> <p><u>Top tip:</u></p> <p>First, find the unit fraction. Then, find the non-unit fraction.</p> <p><i>Divide by the denominator and multiply the answer by the numerator.</i></p> <p>Method to find <math>\frac{3}{4}</math> of 16 =</p> <p>1. <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> of 16 = 16 divided by 4 = 4</p> <p>2. <math>\frac{3}{4}</math> = 4 multiplied by 3 = 12</p>	<p>Here's something a little different to think about and gives you time to learn something really useful, (if you don't already know how to do these things)... You can pick and choose what you'd like to do but these are some ideas...</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Can you prepare a simple meal? Sandwich, fruit salad, make a smoothie or something else?</li> <li>2. Could you learn how to make some bread?</li> </ol> <p><i>The Egyptians sweetened their bread with dates, honey or figs.</i></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>3. Can you help with any gardening? Do you know how to plant a seed? Or help tidy the garden by tidying up the leaves?</li> <li>4. Do you know how to change your bed sheets?
