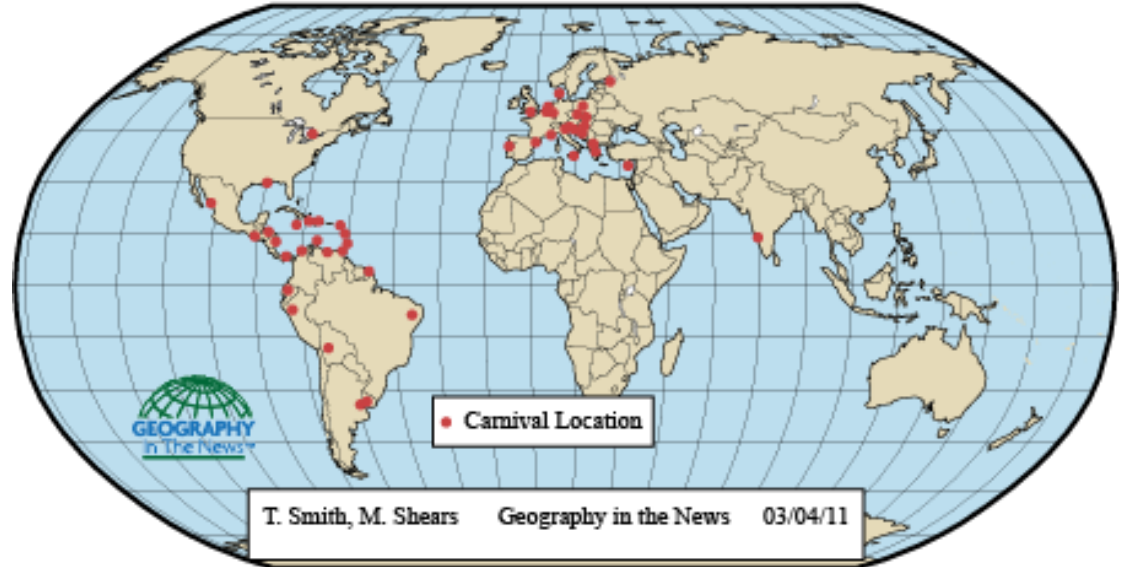


Who celebrates carnival?
